

NEW TESTAMENT SURVEY



1.30 – 2.10 The New Testament survey will be split into two 20 minute sections; The life of Christ followed by the life of Paul.

We will follow the story from Paul's Damascus road experience, with animated maps of his missionary trips, through all the events in the Book of Acts, right up to when Paul stands before the mad Emperor Nero in Rome.

In this unfolding story, we also chronologically date and include where Paul wrote his letters to the churches. This is very helpful and gives the student an immediate understanding to the New Testament letters, without any further research or study.



We have also included and chronologically date the Roman Emperors as the story unfolds. Starting with Augustus the first Roman Emperor in 27 B.C.



Followed by Tiberius, Caligula, Claudius, Nero, Galba, Otho, Vitellius, Vespasian, and lastly Vespasian's son Titus, in 70 A.D.

PURPOSE

However, we do believe that a student of the Bible will have a better understanding of the scriptures, if he/she is first taught that there is just one progressive story that runs through the books of the Bible.

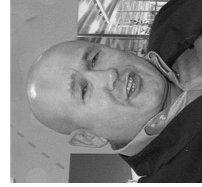

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THE CHRONOLOGICAL BIBLE SCHOOL

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Our objective is to teach the whole Bible as just one story, in a language that everyone who wants to understand the Bible can!

If a person has been taught the Bible in bits and pieces like a jigsaw; he will, no doubt, have a "patchwork quilt" type theology. The Bible will almost certainly be a difficult book to understand, as he will never possess all the pieces.

Consequently, the student will not see the big picture and may not realise that Biblical people, places and events are out of context. As an example, in the Old Testament (Before the Cross) there were three different temples; Solomon's Temple, Zerubabel's Temple, and Herod's Temple.

If the student hasn't received this framework and the timeline at the outset of their Bible study, it becomes very easy to have a distorted view of the temple in the context of the timeline and or Bible prophecy!

When a person knows there is just one story that runs right the way through the Bible, then he will have what we call the "Bible Outline" or the "Bible Timeline" or the "Bible Skeleton." He will then be able to understand where people places and events fit, in this framework.

The creator of The Glory Story can recite the whole Bible as one story in just 10 minutes from Genesis to Jesus, chronologically *dating all the Old Testament books, (except Job) which all connect together to make just one story! As we run through this condensed and fast paced Bible survey, we set the group two simple tasks:-

1. Name three people who wrote books of the Bible during the 70 year Babylonian captivity.
2. Name three of the four people who left the 70 year Babylonian captivity and then wrote books of the Bible.

*DATING: Some dates are approximate; dates are taken from a Strong's concordance.

Ask your church group these two Bible questions! If they are not sure of the answers, we would strongly recommend The Chronological Bible School Presentation!

WHO IS SUITABLE FOR THE CHRONOLOGICAL BIBLE SCHOOL?

The Chronological Bible School is suitable for all age groups; in fact the course is ideal for everyone who would like a better understanding of the big panoramic overview of the Bible. We will travel to your premises on a Saturday; the presentation will take place between 11.00 am – 2.30 pm.

(We will run the school at other times subject to our prior agreement.)

In this three hour presentation, we will present all the books of the Bible (except Job) in chronological order. We will connect all the books together, so the student will complete the course fully understanding that the Bible tells just one historical story from Genesis, to Revelation.

The cost of the course includes a savoury finger buffet lunch, with fruits, cake & soft drinks. The host may provide tea and coffee (optional). All course materials including pens, pencils & worksheets are included. Membership to our online Bible School, with internationally respected Bible teacher Malcolm Smith is also included.

We will also include The Glory Story Old Testament DVD and the New Testament DVD set. The Glory Story film is an overview of the Bible, using moving pictures, narration and music. This DVD set retails in UK stores for £27.90.

OLD TESTAMENT SURVEY

11.00 – 11.10 Introduction talk. **11.10 – 1.00** Old Testament survey. The Old Testament overview will be split into three sections, at the end of each section there will be a work sheet exercise.

SECTION ONE

Creation, Adam, Eve, Noah, the Tower at Babel, the life of Abraham; **1,900 B.C.** God told Abraham to leave his home as God had promised him some land called Canaan. Abraham had two sons Ishmael and then Isaac. Isaac married Rebekah, they had twin sons called Esau & Jacob. Jacob changed his name to Israel.

Israel had twelve sons. One of these twelve sons, Joseph, was put down a well before being sold as a slave into Egypt by his brothers, where around **1,750 B.C.**, he rose to be the prime minister of Egypt. Eventually his brothers, father and other family members joined him in Egypt. (Worksheet)

SECTION TWO

The twelve families from Israel or the Twelve Tribes of Israel, became slaves in Egypt for over **400 years** until God called a deliverer named Moses.

1,330 B.C. Moses led the Twelve Tribes of Israel out of Egypt, through the Red Sea into the wilderness of Sinai, where Moses was given the Ten Commandments. When Moses died **1,225 B.C.** Joshua led the Twelve Tribes from the wilderness into the land God had promised to Abraham, which is today known as Israel. When Joshua died, Judges were appointed to judge Israel for about 250 years. Gideon & Sampson were Judges. Ruth **1,100 B.C.**, lived during the time of the Judges. Samuel was the last Judge and first prophet of Israel. Then we enter the time of the Kings, the first King of Israel was Saul, the second King was King David **1,009 B.C.**

The third King was Solomon, who was the son of David & Bathsheba. Solomon built the temple for the Lord. After Solomon died in **930 B.C.** there were many other Kings. (Worksheet)

SECTION THREE

During this time we also enter the period of the Prophets, Amos, Hosea, Isaiah, Jeremiah etc, until we reach the time Jerusalem and the temple were destroyed in **586 B.C.** when Daniel and Ezekiel were taken into the 70 year Babylonian captivity and Jeremiah wrote his book Lamentations, which is five poems about the destruction of Jerusalem and the temple.

During the 70 year captivity the Babylonians were conquered by the Persians. At the end of the 70 years, the Persian King set the Israelites free. In **520 B.C.** Nehemiah started to rebuild the walls in Jerusalem. At the urging of Haggai & Zechariah, Zerubabel started to rebuild the temple. The temple was completed on March 12th **515 B.C.** and Ezra became the priest.

In the year **479 B.C.** the Jewess Esther, became Queen of Persia. During this time Malachi, the last book of the Old Testament was written.

The four hundred year period from Malachi to John the Baptist is known as the silent years. The Temple was in a continual state of dis-repair and the Persian Empire was eventually conquered by the Greeks, led by Alexander the Great in **334 B.C.**

Eventually the Romans conquered the Greeks and **63 years** before the Messiah, the Roman general Pompey the Great, took control of Jerusalem. So it was that the whole land of Israel became part of the Roman Empire, just as Daniel had prophesied. Under Herod **19 years** before Christ, the rebuilding of the third temple began. The last Old Testament prophet was John the Baptist, his message was; *“Prepare the way for the Lord.”* (Worksheet)
